
Such bold and incisive activities, disturbing to conservatives in Hollywood, have earned for Mr. Kramer the reputation of being a "character" in the community, the foremost of the few willful independents. They invariably speak of "Stanley Kramer and that crowd."

HIS reputation does not in the least worry him. Indeed, he takes a certain satisfaction from being known as a nonconformist. As trim and rugged-looking as a middleweight boxer (with a touch of gray in the hair) and as firm and aggressive as a Marine Corps colonel, he casually bears the load of being the most persistently social-minded producer in America.

What is the explanation for his making the sort of films he does?

"Well, I suppose the best answer is that emotionally I am drawn to these subjects," he said, with some uncertainty, the other day. "To determine why. I'd have to examine my whole youth." then he broke off, "-but we won't go into that now. Nor have I ever bothered to give it any deep or prolonged thought."

Actually, Kramer's youth was not unusual. He was born and reared in New York (Continued on Following Page)



## Jeutonic Mainstay

NE of the best and most revered of Teutonic main dishes is the richly seasoned sauerbraten. This is ineptly translated as "sour pot roast," but what's in a name? However it is called, it is fine winter fare.

Like many good dishes, sauerbraten must marinate for a time in a mixture of vinegar, red wine and seasonings. The meat is then browned and cooked in the marinade and the resultant sauce is rich and as dark as mahogany. Many of the sauerbraten recipes published in this country include gingersnaps for thickening the sauce, but German and Austrian housewives view this as a purely American conceit.

The gingersnaps make the sauce too sweet and are therefore *verboten* in the native recipe.

Sauerbraten is an easy, although somewhat time-consuming, dish to prepare. Mrs. Cecilia Gaige, an American woman who was born in Germany, browns the meat for nearly an hour after it has been marinated, turning it often to give it a uniformly dark color. Her recipe for the dish is printed here.

A traditional dish to serve with sauerbraten is kartoffelklosse, or potato dumplings. A recipe for the dumplings appears on page 94 with the continued step photographs.



NO one, including Mr. Kramer, knows what the consequences of Thursday night's act will be. 
5. Prepare lid: With the hammer and nail, punch two holes close together one inch from the center of the can lid. Two inches directly across the lid from these holes, punch two more holes.

6. Make the radiation indicators: Using the 25-cent coin as a pattern, cut out two circles of aluminum foil.

Cut two lengths of nylon thread of about 15 inches each. Be careful to touch only the ends of the threads. Stretch out the two threads parallel and almost touching on the yardstick so they can be measured at the same time. Do not cross or tangle them.

Measure off five-inch lengths near the center of the two threads. Anchor them to the yardstick with two short strips of transparent tape. Place the tapes just inside the five-inch lengths of thread so that five inches are held taut against the ruler, leaving five inches of thread extending from each side.

Insert a knife beneath the center of one of the five-inch lengths. Raise the thread slightly, but do not touch it with your fingers. Slide one of the quarter-sized circles of foil beneath the knife. Remove the knife, allowing the thread to drop onto the foil. Fold a small edge of foil circle back over the thread to attach it. This fold should be only one half inch long, just enough to hook the foil

Our remedies are ineffectual because they fail to take into account that epidemic crime differs from "ordinary" crime in that a greater degree of irrationality attaches to the former. Irrationality will not yield to law, no matter how stringent. To reduce the contagion we must study the virusirrationality.

It is not the individual offense that is intrinsically irrational. Any crime can be rational, when undertaken by sane people for logical, if disapproved, reasons. When John steals to eat, we understand although we do not condone. When five men and a girl hijack a Portuguese airplane—as happened last month-and drop leaflets over Lisbon urging voters to express their opposition to Premier Salazar, that, too, has a logic.

UST as any kind of crime can be rational, so it can become irrational, whether it be burglary or bombing. It is the offender, not the offense, who makes it so. To comprehend crime epidemics we must, therefore, ask what creates the disturbed individuals who produce them. Why will a man purloin a plane he does not need, cannot sell, and dare not use? Why will he explode a bomb that maims persons he never met? And why does he follow the leader into a given pattern of crime?

An obvious answer is that emotionally unstable individuals do unpredictable, senseless things. Freud found that neurotics suffer from hysteria. And he and Josef Breuer wrote, "The unconscious, split-off mind in hysteria is pre-eminently suggestible \* \* \*." While the authors were concerned only with medical aspects of the phenomenon, their findings are applicable to epidemic crime, for suggestibility is its cornerstone.

something, has come to the hospital nursery and premature babies can now be put to work operating the temperature controls on their own little incubators. How they do it was described at the fall conference of the American Academy of Pediatrics. Actually the business of being one's own thermostat is not too demanding. It only involves having a temperature - sensing element attached to one's abdomen. When the body temperature of a baby thus equipped goes below a prescribed level, the "sensing" element calls for heat and the infra-red lamps which supply it go right to work. We await the day when homes will be provided with bottle-warmers, cradle-rockers and lullaby-loaded hi-fi's that will spring into action at the sound of the first cry.
















his Week's beauty consultant gives advice on lipstick, skin care, eye




